



## PhD TRAINING PROGRAMME – 2009

26-28<sup>th</sup> April 2009

Followed by a Mucosal Immunology Workshop 29-30 April, 2009<sup>1</sup>

The fourth EUROPRISE course for PhD students will take place at Karolinska Institute, Stockholm, Sweden on 26-30 April 2009. Priority will be given to the students from the EUROPRISE PhD programme. Participating students are expected to stay for the full course to obtain the points for a EUROPRISE course. 3-4 courses will be given per year; 6 EUROPRISE points are requested for the full PhD.
